This course is organised for those seeking teaching on basic use of a slit lamp, acquiring biomicroscopy skills and wanting basic understanding of retinal disease and use of OCTs and fluorescein angiography. This is particularly suitable for nurses and other allied medical professions. It is divided into 2 parts:

Session 1 examining normal eyes on the slit lamp and a presentation on normal and abnormal retinal findings and how to interpret an OCT and fluorescein angiogram.

Session 2 is clinic based and patients with retinal disease are examined with an experienced teacher together with their imaging.
